Scotia Saxes performed at the Clarke Museum during Arts Alive!, as well as in Ferndale to help Santa create a festive holiday atmosphere for young and old. The Saxes even weathered the holiday storms to do some traditional caroling in the Victorian Village.

Winema Winds also performed at the Clarke, as well as in the Winema Theater for Rio Dell / Scotia Chamber Christmas movie fundraiser.

The Brass Choir serenaded the Ingomar Club at the Carson Mansion for their annual Holiday Family Night as well as participating in a holiday filming for Access Humboldt.

I am trying a new format for the newsletter. The calendar section includes dates for the entire year. Many are already confirmed and I will update new information for all events as it becomes available as well as remove months and reminders as we pass through them. Next month I will include an attendance roster for each upcoming gig. Any events you will be unable to attend can be noted, creating a visual log for Jill regarding programing and a checklist for the organization of equipment.

The Craft Fair Fundraiser at the River Lodge in Fortuna, although not as profitable as last year, was again successful. This was our 4th year in attendance and we are building a nice customer base for this event.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Last October band members were polled concerning the possible participation in performance events currently not on our annual calendar. The polling resulted in the conclusion that Music Night is a definite addition to the annual calendar. Upon conferring with the Winema Theater scheduling, there are no available dates in 2016 for this event. Reservations were made for March 11, 2017.
- 2. Participation during the Humboldt County Fair was also a favorable event to be pursued. Our participation in the Fair would be subject to several logistical criteria before being added to the calendar.
- 3. Opinion ran in favor of Oktoberfest being a full band event, however our participation in that event depends on our ability to tailor our playlist to the requirements of the hiring committee and would require two rehearsal nights to solidify those selections. At this time it will remain a sub-group event.
- 4. The majority opinion ran against the pursuit of Garberville Rodeo or Rhododendron Parade as possible venues; and the Ferndale Memorial Parade will remain as a volunteer subgroup.

- 5. Over the last few months, the band has acquired timpani, orchestral bells, and concert band music from Miss Dale which will be relocated into our library in the near future. We also have acquired Cherry LaForge's library of flute music and collection of flute publications.
- 6. Please note that prior to the Rodeo Parade on July 16, the railing for the trailer needs to be repainted. This would be best accomplished on Friday afternoon, July 15, after the rails have been installed on the trailer bed. The rails will need to be cleaned first, requiring at least 2 volunteers. We would need at least 6 volunteers for painting to complete in approximately 2 hours. Please contact Sharon if you can participate either in installation, cleaning, or painting. Time will be coordinated with the arrival of the trailer in the staging area.
- 7. Also note that the Holiday Fundraiser at the River Lodge in Fortuna in November will require some volunteer assistance. Since our booth is located on the exterior of the building, we must break down all displays on Saturday and reset everything on Sunday. Since Crystal, Shawn, Ari, and myself man the booth both days, we need assistance with the set-ups and break-downs. We need 2 volunteers on Saturday morning at 7:00 am for initial set-up and 2 volunteers at 4:00 pm for first break-down; as well as 2 on Sunday at 9:00 am and 2 at 3:00 pm for final pack-up and loading. Please contact Sharon if you can help at any of these times.
